



Regular Bay Division Rules

- * ***ALL ENTRANTS MUST HAVE REGISTRATION/WEIGHT CARD ON FILE AT PAVILION BEFORE 10P.M. FRIDAY, MAY 28, 2010 TO WEIGH IN FISH!***
- * Entrants must have a valid 2010 Texas Fishing License and Saltwater Stamp.
- * Each person in the boat **MUST BE** entered in the tournament. **NO OBSERVERS!** No fish will be accepted for judging from a non-registered contestant. Fishermen will be issued a wristband at registration. Fishermen must wear a wristband and show their ticket at weigh-in. Entry fee is \$50. Species are: Red Fish, Trout, & Flounder only. Cash prizes are: 1st - \$400, 2nd - \$200, 3rd - \$100 for each species.
- * Grand Champion will be angler with heaviest stringer of no more than 1 fish per species (angler does not have to catch all three species). Winner gets \$500 cash plus trophy.
- * Fishing hours are from 6pm Friday, May 28, 2009 through 6pm Saturday, May 29, 2010.
- * Weigh-in will be at the Community Pavilion at the Port Mansfield Harbor Y from 12 noon - 6pm Saturday, May 29, 2010. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
- * Winning fish will be determined by weight. Ties will be broken by length. (Lengths will be measured according to the current Texas Parks and Wildlife Department regulations and procedures.)
- * The right to forensically examine any fish will be reserved by the Weigh Master.
- * Fish must be fresh and in edible condition. No mutilated fish will be accepted.
- * All weighed fish will be marked by removing a pectoral fin.
- * An angler cannot win more than one prize in any species.
- * Any fish that does not meet the State Limits at the weigh station will be disqualified.
- * **NO RED FISH OVER 28 INCHES WILL BE ACCEPTED!**
- * **FISH WILL BE WEIGHED ONLY ONE TIME! OUR SCALES AND RULER ARE THE ONLY OFFICIAL MEASURING INSTRUMENTS.**
- * **TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR'S WATCH WILL BE USED FOR OFFICIAL TIME.**
- * **DECISIONS OF THE WEIGH MASTER ARE FINAL!**
- * Entrants and winners may be photographed or included in TV news coverage during or after the tournament.
- * Entrants may be required to submit statements or pass a polygraph test if deemed necessary by the tournament committee; failure to do so may result in disqualification and loss of any awards, prizes, or titles.
